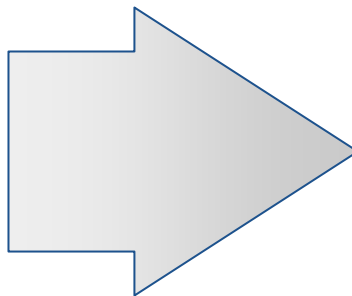

# Purpose of the Grant

## Transformation State Incentive Grant

- Outmoded organizational systems
- Restrictive financial structures
- Fragmented care
- Old technologies



- Systems driven by consumers and families
- Focus on resilience and recovery



# Overview of the Grant

- SAMHSA Funded
- 5 Years
- \$2.7 million per year
- Must address broad based change
- Oklahoma will emphasize infrastructure and sustainable change for both substance abuse and mental health services

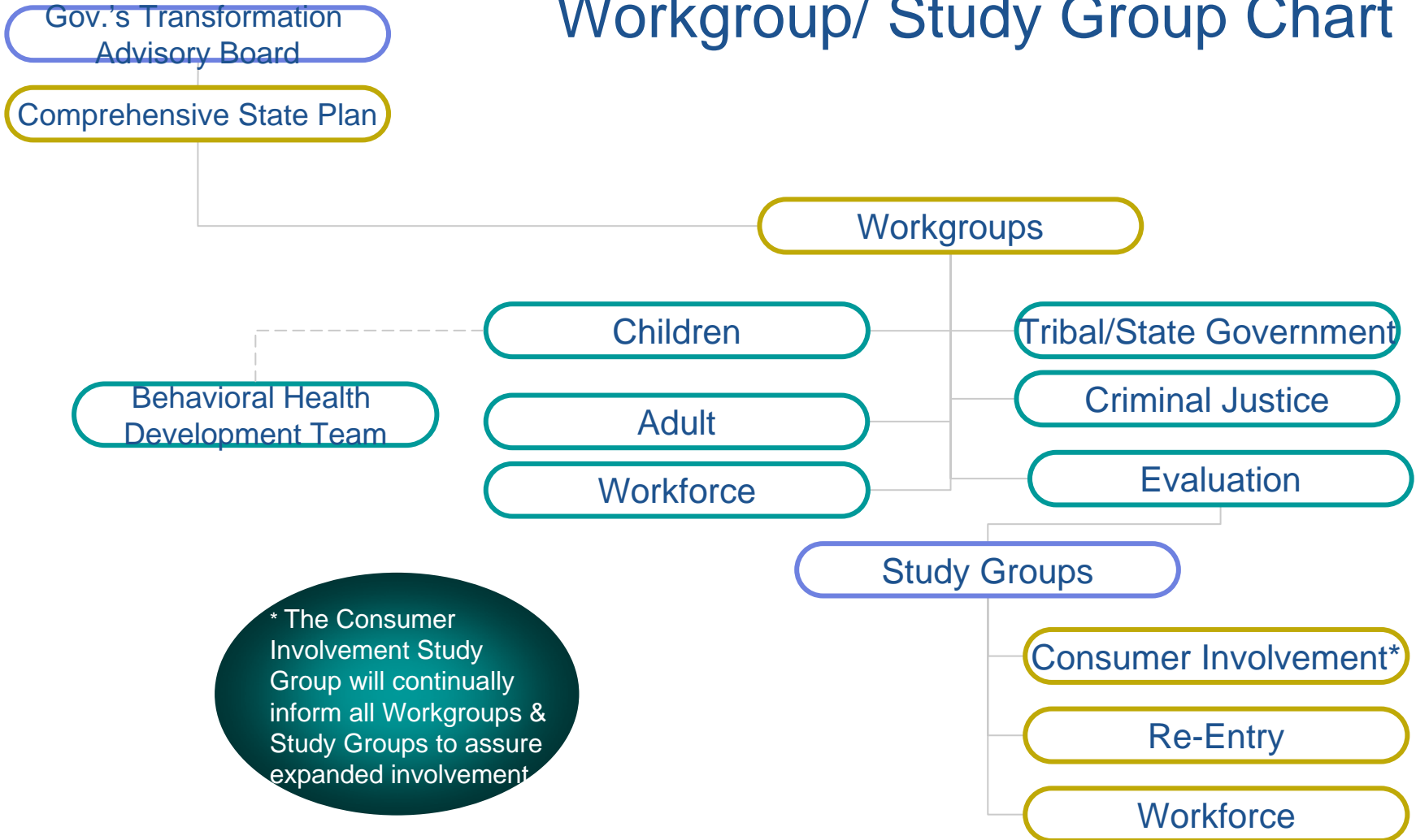

# 1st Year Accomplishments

- Continued support of partnerships and existing activities
- Convened Governor's Transformation Advisory Board
- Developed and staffed Innovation Center
- Completed needs assessment and resource inventory
- Developed comprehensive plan
- Developed evaluation plan



# 2nd Year Accomplishments

- Governor maintains support for Transformation Advisory Board appointees
- GTAB authorizes additional workgroups
  - Tribal & State Government
  - Evaluation
- Needs Assessment approved by SAMHSA
- Comprehensive Plan approved by SAMHSA



## 2nd Year Accomplishments Cont'd

- Technology Coordinator hired
  - Numerous requests for support to existing initiatives and partnership
  - Website enabled with response capability
- Training Specialist hired
  - Focus on training capacity building for partners



## 2nd Year Accomplishments Cont'd

- Conducted “Day of Transformation” summit with internal partners
  - Facilitated as an examination of the Comprehensive Plan



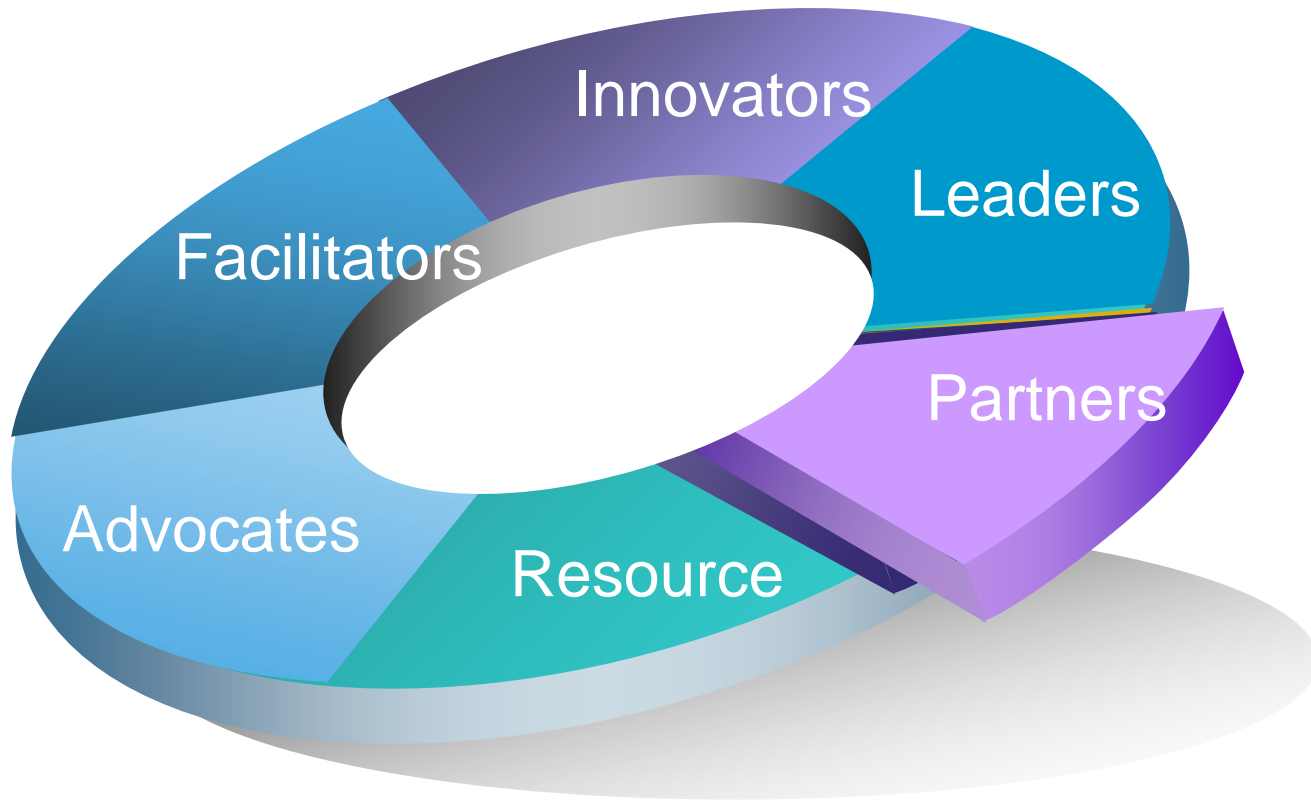


## 2nd Year Accomplishments Cont'd

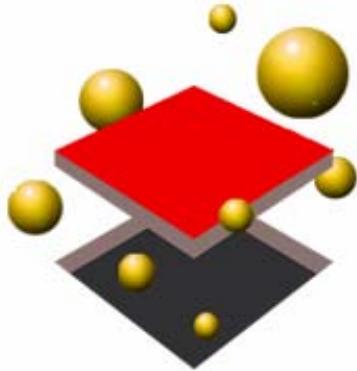
