## FREE MENTAL HEALTH EDUCATION SERVICES

The Youth Mental Health Program offers free mental health education to Oklahoma's youth, including:

- mental health education to 2nd through 12th grade students
- screening, triage and referral for 5th through 12th grade students with parental consent
- non-diagnostic screening and referral for individuals between 11 and 24 years of age (parental consent required for those under 18)
- approved Suicide Prevention Training for Oklahoma Public School staff, as required by SB 21
